Bennington students with Plan concentrations in the social sciences are encouraged to apply for the <u>London School of Economics (LSE) Summer School</u> Scholarship. Each year, Bennington College offers financial support for one student's participation in a three-week summer course at LSE.

The LSE Summer School offers coursework in

- Accounting
- · Business and Management
- Economics
- English Language
- Finance
- International Relations, Government, Psychology and Society
- law
- Research Methods, Data Science, and Mathematics

Successful completion of the summer course will earn three transfer credits.

#### Scholarship funding includes

- LSE Summer Program tuition and registration fees
- Costs of housing in one of LSE's Halls of Residence
- airfare to/from London

#### Criteria

- Applicants must have an approved Plan at the time of application
- · Applicants must be in good academic and disciplinary standing
- Students who will have completed their undergraduate degree prior to the summer session are ineligible
- Students must immediately notify the Provost's Office if they apply for a Leave of Absence or Withdrawal from Bennington College
- Summer LSE programs require a 3.3 GPA; if you do not have a GPA, please speak with the Registrar's Office prior to your application to determine an equivalency
