Dependency Override/Unaccompanied Homeless Youth Determination

The Financial Aid Office has the authority, through Section 480(d)(7) of the Higher Education Act, to change a student's status from dependent to independent in cases involving unusual circumstances.

We cannot process a dependency override for any of the following reasons:

- Parental refusal to contribute to the student's education
- Parental unwillingness to provide information on the application or for verification
- Student is financially self-sufficient
- Parents do not claim the student as a dependent for income tax purposes

If a student does not fall into one of the categories above, they can petition the College to consider them independent based on their personal circumstances. Reasons that the College may grant a student independent status include, but are not limited, to the following:

- Abandonment by the parents
- Parents' location is unknown
- Safety issue in contacting the parents
- Parent incarceration
- Parent long-term hospitalization or institutionalization
- An unaccompanied youth who is homeless or at risk of being homeless

Please follow the steps below to be considered for either a <u>Dependency Override</u> or <u>Unaccompanied Homeless Youth Determination Request</u>. Your application will not be reviewed unless all requirements are met.

- 1. Complete the certification on this form.
- Attach a typed personal statement indicating the relationship with both biological parents and/or a letter which states that you are: unaccompanied and homeless; or unaccompanied, self-supporting, and at risk of homelessness. Include details regarding your current housing situation and how you are supporting yourself.
- 3. Attach at least two (2) personal statements by professional third parties. Professional third parties can include clergy, counselor, teacher, lawyer, etc. A personal acquaintance or family member is not considered a professional third-party reference.
- 4. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) if not already submitted.

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Dependency Override/Unaccompanied Homeless Youth Determination

Definitions:

Unaccompanied: when a student is not living in the physical custody of a parent or guardian. **Homeless**: lacking fixed, regular, and adequate housing.

At risk of being homeless: when a student's housing may cease to be fixed, regular, and adequate.

Self-supporting: when a student pays for their own living expenses, including fixed, regular, and adequate housing.
